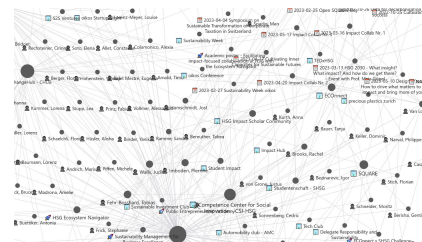

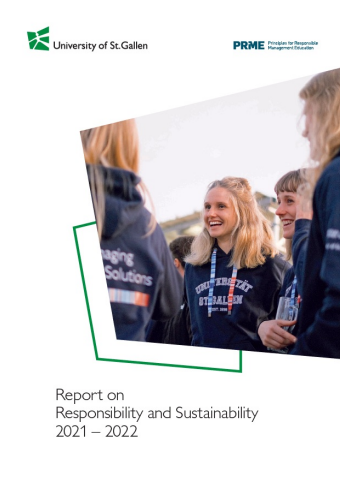
Week against sexual harassment (WASH)
